- a. 82% of chapters submitted VCOC membership reports this quarter, slightly better than last quarter.
- b. With reinstatement of the VCOC dues this year, the membership numbers are the most accurate they have been in 5 yrs. I would recommend continuing this policy so VCOC gets the most accurate numbers at least annually if all chapters do not submit their quarterly reports.
- c. Chapter losses strongly outnumber gains this quarter because of COVID-19 and no meetings/recruiting events, thus no MOAA recruiting award this quarter. I would recommend that chapters continue attempting to recruit new members during this Corona

virus lock-down as more people are at home. I would also suggest that VCOC not think about doing any recruiting awards until 2021.

- f. **Total Chapter Membership in VCOC**: 2485 in 1st qtr. 2020, 1887 in 2nd qtr. A significant drop in membership of <u>25%</u>. What can we do about that **DROP?**
