Areas of emphasis continue to be the Transition Assistance Program as well as membership within the very small active duty component in the ROTC departments of VMI. We continue to have challenges in our recruitment initiatives among the ROTC staff, but are pleased that, for the first time in more than a decade, all three ROTC Professors (Army, Navy/Marine Corps, and Aerospace Studies) are now members of the chapter.

V. Most Significant Chapter Events of the Quarter: We elected officers for 2023 at our October lunch. At our December lunch, we installed the new officers, who will begin their duties on 1 January 2023. At that meeting, we also presented a check for \$5,000 to the Veterans Services Foundation for the benefit of the Virginia Veteran and Family Support program. Mr. Allan Burke, a member of the VSF Board of Trustees, made remarks. We also presented checks for \$3,000 to Rockbridge Area Hospice for the We Honor Veterans program; \$2,500 to the Rockbridge Area Health Center; \$1,000 to Project Healing Waters; and \$1,000 to the Community Table.
