# Richmond Area Chapter VCOC 2024 Mid-Year Report 1 Jan – 30 June 2024

This Meeting featured LTC Kenneth Ruppar, USA, Ret, as guest speaker and key officiant at our Annual Memorial Service honoring 10-chapter members who passed in 2023. Our 17 March, our St Patrick's Day Member Brunch featured Karen Ruedisueli, MOAA's director of government relations for health affairs, providing an informative update on MOAA's legislative priorities for TRICARE and the military health system including efforts to reverse TRICARE pharmacy network cuts, fix TRICARE coverage gaps, and address barriers to access in military treatment facilities. On 15 May we conducted our annual JROTC/ROTC dinner meeting. The highlight was awarding \$1,000 to each of three outstanding cadets.
