- II. **Legislative Affairs:** CDR Prevar kept the chapter officers and membership informed on legislative issues during the period by reports given at virtual meetings, newsletter articles, and the chapter website. He also corresponded regularly with and provided chapter newsletters to staff for US Senators Warner and Kaine and Representatives Connolly, Beyer, and Wexton.
- III. **Chapter Vitality & Levels of Excellence:** In coordination with our Outreach and Membership initiative, information letters were mailed out in January for membership renewal with important information on “Why join the 5 Star Mount Vernon MOAA Chapter.”
- IV. **Most Significant Chapter Events of the Quarter:** JROTC Senior Military Advisors within the Mount Vernon Chapter geographic area were invited to nominate candidates for the chapter’s 2021 JROTC Scholarship Program. Eligibility is limited to graduating high school seniors who have successfully participated in a JROTC program and have been accepted for admission to an accredited institution of higher learning. The student must also enroll in a college-level ROTC or another military program ultimately leading to a commission in one of the U.S. armed forces. Four high schools submitted candidate applications by the 15 March due date, and interviews will be conducted via Zoom on 24 April. The selected candidate(s) will be announced shortly thereafter.
