Additionally, he actively participated in VCOC’s support of MOAA’s Advocacy in Action Campaign through virtual meetings with staff for Representatives Connolly, Beyer, and Wexton.
- III. **Chapter Vitality & Levels of Excellence:** The chapter was awarded a MOAA 5 Star Level of Excellence Award and 5 Star Col Marvin J. Harris Communications Awards for both the Website and Newsletter.
- IV. **Most Significant Chapter Events of the Quarter:** JROTC Senior Military Advisors within the Mount Vernon Chapter geographic area were invited to nominate candidates for the chapter’s 2021 JROTC Scholarship Program. Eligibility is limited to graduating high school seniors who have successfully participated in a JROTC program and have been accepted for admission to an accredited institution of higher learning. The student must also enroll in a college-level ROTC or another military program ultimately leading to a commission in one of the U.S. armed forces. This year the chapter awarded four scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,000. The recipients were: Tatyana Bovarnik, Mount Vernon High School; Ashlie Cabrera, Gar-Field High School; Luke Huddleston, Woodbridge High School; and Zachary Fink, T.C. Williams High School.
